- Item of Jewellery Thurs 21st May between 10.00am - 12.00 noon

No entries will be accepted after these dates.

All entries must have been made within the previous 12 months.

**Victoria Sandwich Recipe**

Ingredients:

- 3 medium eggs weighed in their shells (probably 170g/6oz)
- The weight of eggs in butter/soft margarine
- The weight of eggs in caster sugar
- The weight of eggs in self-raising flour
- Raspberry jam to fill – homemade/good quality

Set oven to 180C/160C (fan)/ gas mark 4.

Grease and line the bottom of two 20cm/8" sandwich tins. Cream butter/margarine and sugar. Beat the eggs then gradually add to the mixture beating well each time. Sieve the flour and fold into the mixture with a metal spoon. Divide equally between the two tins and bake for 25-30 minutes. They are ready when they are golden, shrunk from the side of the tin and spring back when touched. Remove cakes from tins. When cold, fill with raspberry jam. Finish with a light dusting of caster sugar.
