Entry in Class 1 and Class 2 mean the possibility of winning the Charlotte Trophy

Class 1 Baking - A 1lb Loaf of Specialist Bread

Bake a specialist loaf of your own choice.
List the ingredients you have used

Class 2 Baking - Courgette and Cheese Quiche

Bake a quiche with main ingredients courgette and cheese in homemade pastry base approximate size 20cm (8") diameter sandwich tin

Display a quarter section on a plate

Class 3 Baking - 3 Fruit Filled Meringue Nests

3 x 8 cm meringue nests filled with fresh fruit only

Class 4 Baking - A Vegetable Cake

Line a round 20cm (8") diameter cake tin (a purchased cake liner should not be used) and bake a cake with a vegetable as the main ingredient.

List the ingredients highlighting the vegetable used **Ref OWTS p107**

Class 5 Craft - A Cushion Cover from Recycled Material

Make a removable cushion cover from upcycled material. Size approximately 35cm x 35cm.

Take a 'before' photograph of the upcycling material to display with the finished item.

Display with a cushion pad inside

Class 6 Craft - Bird Feeder

Create a bird feeder from upcycled object/s with hook for hanging.

Maximum height excluding hanger 30cm.

Class 7 Craft - Crochet Cotton Shopping Bag

Crochet a string shopping bag using the attached pattern?

Class 8 Photography - 'Climate Change'

A photography on the subject of climate change mounted on A5 card

Class 9 Flower Arrangement - A Seasonal Arrangement in a Jug

Space allowed 24x24x24cm. To be judged from the front

Class10 Co-operative Exhibit - Assorted Afternoon Tea Fancies

To be displayed on a tea tower 2 to 3 tiers of sweet and savoury treats
