Schedule

Day 1: We all meet at the hotel during the afternoon and check in. A local walk of the town is arranged before your 3-course dinner tonight.

Day 2: We travel across the Moors to Whitby where you may wish to visit the Abbey or wander the quaint streets of this historic town. Possibly sampling fish and chips from one of the many restaurants. In the afternoon we join the North York Moors railway along this heritage line to Pickering, where the coach takes us back to Harrogate.

Day 3: A scenic drive through the Dales to Grassington where the village has been used as a location in the latest All Creatures Great & Small series. We then make our way back to visit Bettys for a traditional afternoon tea served in their flagship building in Harrogate, with free time in the town afterwards.

Day 4: In the morning, we have a guided walking tour around York, followed by a visit to the Minster. In the afternoon you have time to explore more of the city at your own pace. May be a trip on the river or visit one of the many museums.

Day 5: Before you depart if you wish we are visiting the RHS Garden Harlow Carr on the edge of the town where the last of the summer flowers are in bloom and autumn tints starting to show.
